Emu Park State School will receive**

\$183,184*

This funding will be used to:

- increase from 88.9% to 92% number of students results being 'C' or greater in English
- increase the average reading disparity across all year levels from 4.4months to 6months
- increase attendance rate from 91.4% to 92.7%
- improve resilience in students by further implementation of our Whole Being Initiative.

Our initiatives include:

- embedding our school's Reading Program including structured reading sessions and individual reading goals for students as well as build our resource collection
- embedding the implementation of Write2Spell2Read program across all year levels
- enhancing Information and Communication Technologies to support the Australian Curriculum implementation
- continuing to implement our school Whole Being Education Program including careful review and adjustment
- enhancing learning opportunities in LEAP through effective resourcing and provision of administration
- scrutinising daily absences and working closely with parents to return students to school as soon as possible
- enhancing the existing knowledge of staff through quality professional development targeting priority areas.
