This funding will be used to

- *Continue refining our four core priorities*
 - *Implement the Australian Curriculum*
 - *Develop competency in reading and writing*
 - *Promote social and emotional competency*
 - *Build capacity in the sharing of practice*
- Increase Year 3 reading in NAPLAN from 407 to >425 by 2021 (413 by 2019)
- Increase Year 5 reading in NAPLAN from 486 to >505 by 2021 (492 by 2019)
- Average of Year 3 & 5 numeracy is greater than state average by 2021
- Increase attendance rate from 90.8% to 92.7%
- Improve resilience in students by further implementation of our Whole Being Initiative.


Our initiatives include

- Embed our school's Reading Program including Structured Reading Sessions and Individual Reading Goals for students as well as build our resource collection.
- Purchase of mathematics resources to allow quality implementation of Australian Curriculum.
- Continue the implementation of our school Whole Being Education Program including careful review and adjustment.
- Enhance learning opportunities in LEAP through employing quality staff.
- Scrutinise daily absences and work closely with parents to return students to school ASAP
- Enhance the existing knowledge of staff through quality professional development targeting inclusive education.
- Reduce time spent on investigating student behaviours through use of CCTV.
- Replace current phone system to ensure effective and safe communication throughout classrooms and wider community.
- Purchase Interactive Whiteboards to allow quality pedagogy and curriculum implementation.

Develop a catering area to enable hospitality studies.	\$7 000
Grounds beautification to align with healthy working and learning place.	\$12 000
Purchase mathematics resources to ensure effective curriculum and pedagogy implementation.	\$7 554
