FOR 2020**

Dear Parents / Caregivers

Emu Park State School offers a Student Resource Scheme for students participating in the Instrumental Music Program.

Monies collected from the Student Resource Scheme will be used for the continuous upgrade, replacement and repair of school instruments and uniforms, purchase of major band/orchestra instruments and equipment, a student district levy and also cover the cost of consumables and other materials as required.

Participation in the Student Resource Scheme is voluntary, and there is no obligation on a parent to participate in the Scheme.

If a parent chooses to participate in the Scheme and completes the attached Student Resource Scheme Participation Agreement Form, a fee will be due and payable by the parent as below:

- \$25 Levy per student per year to cover the replacement and repair of music uniforms, a student district levy and the cost of consumables and other materials as required.
- \$50 Instrument Hire for beginning students requiring Percussion, Violin or Viola for 1 year only to cover the continuous upgrade, replacement and repair of school instruments, purchase of major band/orchestra instruments and equipment.
- \$100 Instrument Hire for beginning students requiring Brass, Woodwind, Double Bass and Cello for 1 year only to cover the continuous upgrade, replacement and repair of school instruments, purchase of major band/orchestra instruments and equipment.

Payment of the above fee is a requirement for participation in the Instrumental Music Program. Please note that the Scheme does not cover costs incurred for transporting students to and from events by bus. Students will be required to cover these costs under a user pays system.

The Student Resource Scheme Participation Agreement Form is required to commence in the scheme and covers the student during their enrolment at Emu Park State School. The External Request for Equipment (EDQUIP EQ11) Form covers the hire of the instrument and must be returned by **21 February, 2020** to enable the hire instrument to be provided to the student as part of the Instrumental Music Program at Emu Park State School.

Finally, the more students who participate in the Program, the more enhanced the Instrumental Music Program will be. We look forward to your participation in the Student Resource Scheme, which is endorsed by the Emu Park State School P&C Association.
